

Controlled Substance Certification / Registration

Current controlled substance registrations (CSR) issued by the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) are required to write prescriptions for controlled substances.

If at any time you obtain a DEA, you must notify Central Credentialing and provide current documentation for inclusion in your credentials file. If at any time your DEA is voluntarily or involuntarily reduced, suspended, limited, revoked, cancelled or diminished, or you elect to not renew your DEA, you must notify Central Credentialing within 15 days of said action or the non-renewal.
