- Support the Interfaith Community Clinic for underserved Montgomery County residents – in FY24, we provided nearly \$1 million in services
- Develop free educational events for area EMS, school nurses and nursing students to further develop their skills and knowledge base, while also collaborating with area schools and the new [HEAL High School](#) in Aldine ISD to help inspire and train more medical professionals
